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To Business Owners

In the context of the health crisis, new measures were implemented on August 7, 2021, also modifying certain measures taken on July 21.

Here is a summary of the main changes:

Extension of the validity period of tests and self-tests from 48 hours to 72 hours

Removed the 50-person gauge

Addition of details on the provisions specific to each ERP

Extension of the scope of the measures put in place on July 21 to:

- Sports competitions and events
- Fair festivities
- Restaurants, drinking establishments, floating establishments and hotels offering catering
- Stores > 20,000m²
- Trade fairs and exhibitions, as well as certain professional seminars (> 50 people)
- Healthcare facility for people with scheduled care as well as those accompanying a patient (with the exception of people accompanying children)
- Travel by interregional public transport

In more detail, here are the provisions applicable from August 7, 2021:

Adults must, in order to be accommodated in the establishments, places, services and events mentioned below, present one of the following documents:

1. The result of a screening examination, a test or a self-test carried out less than 72 hours before entering the establishment, place, service or event
2. Proof of vaccination status
3. A certificate of reinstatement

The presentation of these documents can be checked by:

- Operators of passenger transport services;
- The people responsible for border health checks;
- Those in charge of places, establishments and services or the organizers of events to which access is subject to their presentation;
- Control officers empowered to record infringements.

If one of these documents is not presented, access to the establishment, place, service or event is refused, except for people with a medical contraindication to vaccination.

The documents mentioned must be presented for the access of participants, visitors, spectators, customers or passengers to the following establishments, places, services and events:

1) Establishments with cultural, sporting, fun or festive activities:

- a) L-type hearing, conference, screening, meeting, performance or multipurpose rooms;
- b) Marquees, tents and structures, belonging to the CTS type;
- c) Type R establishments, with the exception of:
 - for artistic education establishments, professional practitioners and people enrolled in training courses delivering a vocational diploma;- establishments for the reception of pupils receiving initial education regardless of the cycle or enrolled in training preparing for higher education;
- d) Type R higher education establishments, for activities which are not part of a training course or which welcome spectators or external participants;
- e) Playrooms and dance halls, falling under type P;
- f) Commercial establishments intended for exhibitions, trade fairs or exhibitions of a temporary nature, falling under type T;
- g) Outdoor establishments, of the PA type, access to which is usually controlled;
- h) Covered sports establishments, under type X, access to which is usually controlled;
- i) Establishments of worship, under type V, for events not of a religious nature;
- j) Museums and halls intended to receive cultural exhibitions of a temporary nature, falling under type Y, except for persons entering these establishments for professional reasons or for research purposes;
- k) **libraries and documentation centres**, with the exception, on the one hand, of university libraries, specialized libraries and, except for the exhibitions or cultural events they host, of the National Library of France and the Public Information Library and, on the other hand, people accessing these establishments for professional or research purposes;

2) Cultural, sporting, fun or festive events organized in public space or in a place open to the public and likely to give rise to control of the access of people

3) Ships and boats offering trips with accommodation

4) Sports competitions and events subject to an authorization or declaration procedure and which are not organized for the benefit of professional or high-level athletes

5) Fairgrounds with more than thirty stands or attractions

6) Restaurants, drinking establishments, mountain restaurants and, for their catering and drinking establishments, floating establishments and hotels, falling under types N, OA, EF and O, except for:

a) Room service in hotel restaurants and bars;

b) Collective catering under management and under contract;

c) Professional railway catering;

d) Professional road catering, on the basis of a list, drawn up by the representative of the State in the department, of establishments which, given their proximity to road axes, are frequented in the usual way by transport professionals ;

e) The take-away sale of prepared meals;

f) Non-commercial catering, in particular the free distribution of meals.

7) Sales stores and shopping centers, falling under type M, comprising one or more buildings whose calculated cumulative useful commercial area is greater than or equal to twenty thousand square meters, by reasoned decision of the representative of the State in the department, under conditions guaranteeing people's access to essential goods and services as well as, where appropriate, to means of transport.

The area mentioned is calculated under the following conditions:

a) The useful commercial area is the total area including the sales areas, offices and reserves, without deduction of hopper or post and calculated between the axes of party walls with the private parts, and the exterior bare of party walls with the common parts. The surface is taken into account regardless of the prohibitions on public access;

b) A sales store or shopping center is understood to mean any establishment comprising one or more sets of sales outlets, including when they have independent direct access, in particular by public highway, and possibly other establishments open to the public. able to communicate with each other, who are, for their access and evacuation, dependent on closed e-mails. All the useful commercial areas are added together to determine whether the 20,000 m² threshold has been reached, including in the event of the closure, even temporarily, of closed e-mails connecting one or more establishments or buildings.

8) Trade fairs and exhibitions as well as, when they bring together more than fifty people, professional seminars organized outside establishments carrying out the usual activity.

9) Health, social and medico-social services and establishments, as well as military health establishments, for reception, except in emergency situations and except for access to screening for covid-19, the following people:

a) Upon admission, people admitted to health establishments and services for scheduled care;

b) Persons accompanying those accommodated in these services and establishments or visiting them, excluding persons accompanying children.

10) Long-distance trips by interregional public transport, except in the event of an emergency preventing the obtaining of the required proof:

- a) Public air transport services;
- b) National rail transport services with compulsory reservation;
- c) Regular non-contracted collective road transport services.

When the provisions are applicable beyond a threshold defined in number of people accommodated, this threshold is determined according to the number of people whose reception is planned by the operator of the establishment or place or by the organizer of the event or service, in compliance with the rules applicable to them and the limitations provided for by decree.

When activities take place outside the establishments and places, the provisions are applicable as if they took place in these establishments and places, within the limits of the spaces and times concerned.

These provisions are applicable, from August 30, 2021, to employees, public officials, volunteers and other people who work in the places, establishments, services or events concerned, when their activity takes place in the spaces and at the times when they are accessible to the public, with the exception of delivery activities and except emergency response.

The mask-wearing obligations do not apply to people who have entered establishments, places, services and events with the exception of long-distance trips by interregional public transport. Wearing a mask may however be made compulsory by the departmental prefect when local circumstances justify it, as well as by the operator or the organizer.

Coronavirus information - Health protocol and reservations

We are collectively facing a health and economic crisis unprecedented in our history.

From 9 August 2021, a sanitary pass is requested for access to certain accommodations.

- **Health pass – August 9, 2021**

The sanitary pass:

The sanitary pass is required from the 1st customer for rentals that offer breakfast, table d'hôtes as well as for those that offer common places and activities (common room, common kitchen, common pool, common wellness area, etc ...). This therefore applies to bed and breakfasts, group cottages, campsites, holiday villages but also to cottages with communal swimming pools It is not required for rentals that offer only an accommodation activity with or without private equipment (swimming pool, wellness area).

Cancellation policy:

In case of cancellation of a stay due to the absence of sanitary pass, the general conditions of sale (GTC) apply.

In case of new confinement, or closure of borders, our reservation services will give you the choice between the postponement or the refund of your stay (excluding service fees and insurance premium).

Outside confinement, if you still wish to cancel your stay, the general conditions of sale signed when finalizing your contract, will apply.
